We have God's promise that God will be with us wherever we go. I believe the answers to our questions should be simple. **FOCUS!**


Fix our eyes on Jesus (prayer)

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know there is a meaning to every stained glass window in the Sanctuary? On the east wall:

- 1. Easter lily Symbol of immortality (the bulb decays in ground, but a new flower of life comes forth)
- Manger and star Symbol of the entrance of Christ into the world. Star is five pointed or Epiphany Star pointing up the "manifestation of Jesus to the Gentiles" (Matthew 2:12)


